

Dear Parent/Carer

Bebington High Sports College prides itself on how it safeguards its students whilst in school.

A part of this safeguarding is that no person can come into school or the site without identifying themselves, logging their presence and being accompanied by a member of staff. In fact, the only way onto our school site between 8.45 am and 3.00pm is via reception.

This term, I have become a little concerned about the increasing number of parents and carers who are coming on site at the end of the school day for a variety of reasons. This makes driving onto the car parks and using the student exit doors hazardous in some circumstances.

I fully realise that parents are only attempting to collect or meet their daughters or sons. However, their actions could potentially cause increased risks to our students. Cars coming onto the car park have not only prevented our specialist transport from being able to collect our youngsters, but also cause hazards to students walking out of school.

Although staff are always present, we cannot always identify who adults are quickly enough which again, could potentially cause a risk to our students. For this reason, I must ask parents/carers with cars not to enter the car parks. Additionally, no adult should come onto our school site unless they sign in at reception and identify themselves.

I fully appreciate and accept that in most circumstances people are only wishing to collect their children; however, I have a duty of care for all of our youngsters and take very seriously our responsibility for all the children in our care.

Can I thank you for your co-operation in helping us to ensure all our students are safe. I have instructed all my staff to stop and question anyone on site, including car parks, throughout the school day and especially in the evening when students are leaving school.
