Community Cohesion Policy

At Bebington High Sports College our mission is to create an environment where all students are accepted and valued. The impact is seen in the very low level of ethnic/racial incidents, indicating the high level of cohesion with our community.

Our Embedded Police Officer works within the wider community to reinforce our values along with the Community Specialism Plan and achievement of intermediate International award.

We work hard to understand our cohort. We use IDACI and KS2 data to have a full understanding of the needs of each cohort that joins the school. Data is analysed and checked to ensure that students from different ethnic and social backgrounds are not being disadvantaged. Teachers have access to all the relevant information to aid awareness and planning.

Within the curriculum the Yr7 REAL Curriculum and Culture Philosophy and Religion course is of a very high standard through the key stages and demands a high level of reflection and engagement by our students. We actively support our students of different faiths and ethnicity when it impinges on their attendance and engagement in whole school activities.

Our specialism has had significant impact in the local community providing KS1 and KS2 students in our partner primary schools with two hours quality PE within the curriculum. The specialism works hard to ensure this is high quality by providing a range of teachers, coaches and adults supporting learning. This has been carried out by an effective collaborative partnership with the LDA.

A collaboration of our Specialism, SSP and the PCT work together with other appropriate organisation to develop the health and well-being of young people attending the Saturday Youth Night.

Collaborative work with our SSP and LDA enables us to provide a range of OSHL opportunities both competitive and non competitive for students in mainstream, pupils with LDD and pupils with emotional and behavioural difficulties for our outreach schools across the LA; a Gifted and Talented programme for pupils with both LDD and in mainstream; a Leadership and Volunteering programme and comprehensive CPD opportunities.

BHSC offers a variety of training opportunities for young people and adults with the local community during evening, weekends and school holidays.
