# Internet safety tips

## *THINK U KNOW...*

- It's best not to give out your personal details to online mates.
- Personal information includes your messenger id, email address, mobile number and any pictures of you, your family or friends.
- If you publish a picture or video online – anyone can change it or share it.
- SPAM/ Junk email & texts: don't believe it, reply to it or use it.
- It's not a good idea to open files that are from people you don't know. You

won't know what they contain – it could be a virus, or worse – an inappropriate image or film.

- It's easier to get on with people online and say stuff you wouldn't face to face.
- Some people lie online.
- It's better to keep online mates online. Never meet up with any strangers without an adult you trust. Better to be safe than sorry!
- It's never too late to tell someone if something makes you feel uncomfortable.
